Dear Friends and Supporters,

Please forgive our lack of communication lately; we have been busy with the ministry. Yet, we would like you to know how to pray with us. This newsletter has lots of information for you to pray to and praise the Lord.

We plowed the camp road on May 31st so we could begin our summer season work. Insurance investigators came to the sight in March, but could not see all the utilities in the snow so they came back June 8th. There is still no settlement. We will still be in need of additional funds for the completion of the new lodge. To rebuild we are looking at about twice that amount as we have many codes to meet. Please continue to pray for all those details, God's provision, wisdom and safety.

The kitchen tent was approved, set up and is running. It works very well, and we praise God for his wisdom and provision of that. It was a lot of work that Phillip Loftus did to plan all of that, yet he and his wife do a wonderful job. What a blessing to have them as interns this year! Please continue to pray for God's provision. We still need a large mixer (a Hobart) and many other kitchen supplies. Yet, when you walk in the tent it is like walking into a kitchen. What a blessing! God is always good! David got the refrigerator divided for freezer/fridge and it is running. It is a refrigeration trailer like semi-trucks pull.

We have a contractor here at camp that closed his building business in Wisconsin for the season and is working hard with his son to help us guide the lodge rebuild. Please pray for his wife and kids as they need details lined up before they come and for God's provision for them as he is helping us full time up at camp.

Summer staff training went well. We have had lots of work here at camp with just setting up. We are all working well together while being flexible to how God wants us to function this summer. "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience." James 1:2-3. Praise God things are up and functioning well. We have 15 port-a-potties all over camp and a trailer that holds 6 showers that some men from our church and David put together. David was also able to set up the phone booster with the help of a friend. Praise God for his provision of helpers to come alongside to help David with his tasks at camp!

Praise God that Teen 1 was a blessing. Every teen I asked, answered that they were enjoying their time. Many shared how God used the speaker and how God was ministering to them. What a blessing it was to hear that from them! This is the reason we are here, to serve, so God can speak to our campers' hearts. Please pray for us all. God is doing tremendous things here at camp!

While camp was going on this past week, work continue to take the lodge down, and logistics were adjusted to minister to our campers and summer staff. God's abundant grace continues to overflow. Even though it has been hard to see all that work removed, we know that God's plans are so much better than ours. So we praise Him even now!

About the lodge. Four big trailers carried metal out these past two weeks. A construction crew is working very hard on cleaning the site. They have separated metal for scrap metal, wood to the burn pile, concrete to be crushed later on and put down for road base and the concrete foundation was taken out. They have been very kind and mindful of their work and taken time to just encourage us staff. It has been a lot of work to take down the lodge! Would you pray for safety? Please continue to pray for us all! God continues to provide, and we have received some large gifts that will help us upgrade our infrastructure to both operate this summer and be able to start rebuilding. We are trusting in God for all these details. We also have many people volunteering. We have a crew lined up to help with the foundation and walls. Getting the volunteers scheduled is a big deal to getting our timeline worked out. Would you pray that God will be helping us in these details? Thank you for taking time to pray for us and Red Cliff Bible Camp.

We know that many of you are praying and even though we have not sent an update in a while, we want you to know that we are all working hard and very much appreciate your prayers. 1. Dirt work and demolition in the month of June. (Completed!).
2. Footers, foundation and slab in the month of July.
3. Walls in the month of August.
4. Roof and dry in, in the month of September. Which will give us plenty of work for the winter, before winter camps!

Please pray for our water level as we start digging this month, Lord willing. God's ways are perfect! New power lines and water lines are being put down. Please pray for David as he has lots to do and would appreciate your prayers. Pray for safety. Praise God for His protection in all the details. We trust that God will do great things this summer! Psalm 100:5 says "For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations." Our God is always good, and we continue to trust in His goodness. Please continue to pray for all of us.
