We had friends drive the gravel needed for it, and we had **a team from Utah come and set the trusses up on the lodge. A team from Casper came and set the metal roof and a group from town put up the chimney. These are all skilled men (and a lady) who work construction for a living. It was so amazing to see them give their time and expertise so the roof and septic field will be done properly.** We cannot say enough how thankful we are for volunteers and helpers. **We praise God for all the help we had for ladies' retreat.** We had pastors and deacons from Wyoming and Utah serving together so the Gospel could be shared, hearts encouraged and so we ladies could sit and learn right along with our campers. Thank you!

We thank each of you for your prayers, encouragement and support. Prayers are a main part of our ministry; we are humans and can get tired, discouraged and overwhelmed. Yet, when the retreat started and the metal roof was going on and the ladies were walking in, all of a sudden, I (Wixi) started feeling a peace about the retreat. It was so encouraging and I knew it was because of prayer. **God has been so gracious and full of compassion. We saw God at work in marvelous ways during our last ladies' retreat.** The ladies were so gracious to share with us the way God worked in their hearts, and it was so encouraging to see that God did minister to each of those hearts.

Please pray for us. The guys keep working. **The roof needs to have the ridge cap on and the chimney needs the metal flashing around the rock.** This is all just little loose ends. Yet they need to be done. **The boys' bathrooms have a septic field now, but the bathrooms are not done. Please pray for David to have the wisdom to prioritize what he needs to be doing.** There is lots of maintenance around camp that is behind and needs to be done. **Pray for the electric. On October 08 we are hoping the ground will be dry to pour concrete for the transformer and on October 18 the Lower Valley Power Company will be there to work on it. Pray for wisdom and pray for provision to finish the loose ends at camp before snow falls. Pray for safety. We know that God's plans are perfect and we are trusting that He is guiding us.** Thank you for praying.

Here the leaves are changing, the snow is in the mountains around town and it keeps coming to camp and melting off. **Wixi continues to homeschool the boys and it is going well.** The boys are doing better at sitting yet we have to keep them focused on their school, especially Leonard since his classes go longer than Joseph's since he is in 2nd grade. **Anah Grace is doing well at the school.** She has invited friends to church. **We are praying for God to give the fruits in His time. Please pray for Anah Grace as she will have a bilateral distal medial 8-plate on November 05.** All it means is that her knees are moving to the inside again, with the difference that this time it is both of them. **Please pray that it will be corrected. They will put the 8 plate with the screws in both knees.** Please pray for wisdom since she will see a hand and arm doctor in the next few months to check her left elbow that is locking and her right hand since it is getting tighter.

We praise God that He is in control of our family. We thank Him for His goodness. Friends of ours are willing to sell us their 2009 Ford Expedition for a good price. We have prayed about it and God has supplied most of the money. We have prayed for a bigger vehicle for a long time since our kids are tall and especially Anah Grace is very tight in the truck when we travel. We feel this will allow us to drive one vehicle when family or friends come and help us transfer more than just our family. **Please pray for wisdom regarding this vehicle that it will be truly what God wants us to do.**

We want to thank God for allowing David's parents to come. They were here in our home for a month. **They were a sweet encouragement, a help and a blessing. We enjoyed very much our time with them.** This December they will be 50 years married (600 months). They are a great example to us and they are our prayer partners.
