In January after the North lodge pipe froze, the guys and interns spent many hours repairing, cleaning and getting ready for camp. The amount of snow was unbelievable so we had many hours of just shoveling snow from everywhere.

On February after our second couples retreat, our main lodge burned down. Kitchen, bathrooms, dining room, coffee shop, history room, meeting room, Mr. Dean's office (our director) and the speaker's room where he slept were all lost.

God in His mercy encouraged us all in an amazing way. The guys had a trip to visit the Wilds camp with the interns already set up for March, so it was great time for them to watch the way they use their tools for God's Glory. Most of March, April, and part of May were so busy with planning for the logistics for the summer and making a detailed list of all that was lost in the fire. The end of May we prayed for the snow to melt. The road to camp was plowed May 30.

June, July, August and September involved a lot of hours serving at camp. Every camp ran well. With the first one, we learned a few things that needed to be tweaked. Yet what an answer to prayer to be able to run with a kitchen tent, porta potties, trailers for our coffee shop and store, outside sink and all the things that needed to happen.

In August, our interns finished with their internship. They were a big blessing to our ministry and a great asset when we needed it most. And we order our homeschool material for Anah Grace's 4th grade and Leonard Allen's kindergarten.

From June to October. Phase 1: the dirt work and demolition in June was Completed! Phase 2: footers and foundation walls were Completed! The ground has been back filled around the foundation. We continue to pray for God's perfect timing, wisdom and provision as we wait for summer to continue forward with the building progress. We are praying for skilled help to set up the electric, drain and water pipes before the slab is poured. Please pray with us that we will have enough volunteer help and good weather to get this accomplished in the summer. One of the boys cabins was sand blasted, stained and the beginning work for future bathrooms was started.

Phase 3 will be the walls and in phase 4, the roof and dry-in. We truly don't know what God has ahead. We had 4 salvations this past summer and we look forward to what the Lord will do this year at camp. We trust in His guidance!

During end of October, the guys did a lot putting away summer activities and started working on winter plans for logistics and purchasing 2 porta potties.

November and first 2 weeks of December. Mr. Dean, Mr. MacGill, and David worked on the kitchen set up in the pavilion. What a blessing and privilege it is to serve our God.

We shared in our last email that during Christmas we would take 2 weeks to visit both our families. It was a refreshing and a blessing to see them and share how God is working in each of our lives. We were able to visit with each of our parents and siblings except one of Wixi's brother and family.

Through the whole year we saw God's plan at work. We had many helping hands, praying hands, and supporting hands. Thank you to each of you that prayed for us along the way.
